MAKE SURE YOU TELL THE COMPANY WHAT YOU THINK OF THEIR PROPOSED AGREEMENT – VOTE NO!

Dear Members

This week we filed a dispute with the Fair Work Commission following Aurizon Bulk's refusal to abide by the 2015 EBA – the company have refused:

1. To develop a master roster in accordance with the master roster development clause in the agreement
2. To concede the dispute clause applied to the dispute we raised
3. To abide by status quo!

The relevant ROM wrote to us and said he was 'comfortable' with breaching the 2015 agreement because the depot had been 'engaged by management'!

These are the same people buying into how your proposed agreement is written. If this management approach is what Aurizon Bulk are happy to pull under the current agreement, imagine how they are going to develop rosters under the proposed company written agreement!

I'm told the bosses are telling you not to vote at all if you are going to vote no.
