## Aurizon Bulk Master Rosters

Dear members,

In recent weeks the AFULE state office have been in discussions with Aurizon Bulk in an attempt to reduce tuckerbox jobs and increase DOO workings where possible. It was hoped from the outset that these changes could be completed to your current master rosters and would not signify a major change.

After viewing initial roster changes that the company had proposed, it became apparent that the flagged changes were significant. The AFULE then wrote to Aurizon seeking that roster committees are convened and that new master rosters are developed as described by your 2019 Enterprise Agreement.

I can confirm that any new depot master rosters will be developed in conjunction with the depot master roster committees and *not* consulted as described in an employee update released Thursday 23/4/20. I can also confirm that senior Aurizon management have written to me informing that an effort will be made to reduce tuckerbox jobs and insert stock trains through this process.

I will remain in close contact with our roster committees as these rosters are developed and keep the wider membership updated.
