## Aurizon Coal Traincrew Enterprise Agreement Bargaining Commences

Dear members,

This Tuesday and Wednesday AFULE officials and workplace representatives met with Aurizon in Brisbane to commence "Traincrew Stream" bargaining for your upcoming Traincrew Enterprise Agreement.

The rail unions and Aurizon exchanged our stream log of claims and healthy discussions took place on many AFULE log claims including:

- Rostered 12-hour shifts and shift extensions
- Maximum time between rostered shifts
- Reducing roster movements
- Alternate master roster options
- Increased RDO cancelation protections
- Transparent access to annual and long service leave
- Long service leave deductions
- Not being rostered to work into leave
- Increased public holiday payments
- Re-Introduction of a depot transfer system
- In cab video and audio surveillance

In all, discussions were healthy, and all parties participated in good faith. There is no doubt however, a long way to go with these negotiations.

Traincrew bargaining continues Wednesday the 7<sup>th</sup> and Thursday the 8<sup>th</sup> September. I will be sure to update members as more details of bargaining comes to hand.
