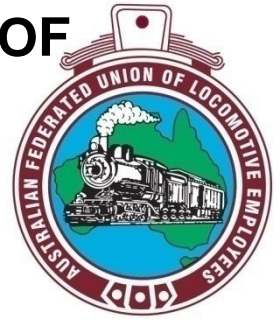

Say 'NO!' to Penalty Rate Cuts for Queensland Workers

Dear Members

Over the past week thousands of union and community members from across Queensland have told clubs, big and small, that the community expects local clubs to continue paying weekend penalty rates to workers who work weekends.

There are still a number of big clubs that have not responded. Submissions to the Fair Work Commission on changes to or abolition of the Clubs Award close [on Friday 24 March](#), and we need as many of the big clubs as possible to stand up and say they want no part of cutting penalty rates for weekend workers.

By going to <http://www.fairpayclubs.com/top> you can see a list of Top Target Clubs that are yet to respond to the communities call to not touch penalty rates. From that site you can email the clubs to ask them their position, or pick up the phone and call them.

Help stop workers being exposed to cuts to penalty rates. Tell your local club they have a choice to do what the community expects them to – that is, stand up for the weekend and stand up for the people that work them.
