Stirrat Consultation Update

Dear members,

Last week I wrote to Callemondah ROM, Danielle Ayscough with a number of initial questions as a result of the Stirrat consultation document. The response to the questions can be found [here](#).

Since releasing the original consultation document, there has also been updated FAQs released by the company. These updated FAQ's have simply muddied the water and leaves us with a simple question. Is the Stirrat proposal a standalone depot or a Callemondah multi sign on point? Depending on what document you read or who you speak to, the answer to this question is different. This is an important question that we need a direct response to.

As a result, the AFULE wrote to the company seeking an extension to the consultation/EOI timeframe and a meeting to be convened with senior Coal South management. This meeting is taking place Friday 23 April. The consultation period has been extended through until COB Wednesday 28 April and the EOI period being extended through until COB Friday 30 April 2021.
